### 3) Draft terms of reference

Clerk issued all members with a draft Terms of Reference based on the model document in the Neighbourhood Planning Guidance. There was a discussion around how the membership should be made up, in particular around how many Parish Councillors can sit on the Steering Group. There was a suggestion that it should be no more than  $1/3^{rd}$  of the maximum of 12 Steering Group members. This raised the issue of people wearing two hats within the community and being able to sit on the Steering Committee as a representative of another organisation rather than for the PC.

It was agreed that the Interim Steering group has to be based on who is around the table at the moment and to include Madeleine and Vereen in their absence, and that this could be reviewed as time goes on and interest from the community grows.

There was a suggested change to the wording in the Terms of Reference, as follows:

#### "Membership:

The Steering Group will include up to 12 members, including representatives of the Parish Council and any interested members of the community, from each of the settlement areas including, Lamas, Badersfield, Buxton and Little Hautbois, as approved by the Parish Council."

## 4) Communication Strategy

Clerk circulated a draft communication strategy for reference.

There was a suggestion that the group should start a social media page to try and engage more people in the process. Kandi was keen to lead on this and create a Neighbourhood Plan Facebook page. The school FB page was also pointed out as a good way to communicate with residents.

Tim agreed to draft a Communication Strategy for the group. There is an aspiration to have this strategy in place for the 1<sup>st</sup> March 2018.

The group decided to appoint an interim Chair, Vice-Chair, Secretary and Treasurer. This can be reviewed when necessary.

Chairman – Tim Curtis was proposed by Kandi and seconded by Thea. All agreed

Vice-Chair – Rev Hagan-Palmer was proposed by Thea and seconded by Val. All agreed.

Treasurer – Rosemary was proposed by Kandi and seconded by Rev Hagan-Palmer. All agreed.

Secretary – Clerk agreed to carry on as acting secretary for the time being. All agreed.

## 5) Topics for next meeting

Communication – What are the group communicating on?

Consultancy – Clerk to ask Richard Squires to attend the next meeting to give his guidance on the use of consultants.

Clerk to circulate to all the photos of the gant chart/time line that was created at the first meeting with Richard Squires.

Clerk to find out when the next Broadland District Council Neighbourhood Plan meeting will be taking place.
